
Public schools are emotionally, spiritually and intellectually stifling.

The Association of Christian Schools in Spain (CSS) is a registered Spanish non-profit association, with the goal of starting a network of Christ-centered schools around Spain.

The board of CSS is comprised of eight members representing seven different nationalities; all with a heart for seeing spiritual transformation in the lives of Spanish children and youth.

Mission Statement

Establish a network of Christ-centered, international schools across Spain, which equip and inspire students academically, spiritually and socially, empowering them to become persons of influence in their families, churches, communities and society.

First fruits: Introducing



LIFE International School is the first CSS school; a Christ-centered educational model offering an affordable, English-immersion education with small class sizes and individualized instruction.

LIFE is the only Christ-centered school specifically targeting Spanish families in all of Spain.


LIFE is in our 4th year of operation, with 46 students in preschool through 6th grade.











LIFE partners with parents and churches to help in the training and spiritual formation of their children.

LIFE is training future Christian leaders, resourced with scholarship and ability to train others.

LIFE is a private, international school; free to determine curriculum and methodology.

How will we grow?

We are creating a culturally sensitive, self-sustaining, reproducible network of Christ-centered schools.


We envision a central, purpose-built campus in Tres Cantos extending through 12th grade, with feeder schools in various surrounding city neighborhoods (to serve Madrid).



This model will be replicated in other cities of influence around Spain (Valencia, Seville, Barcelona, Zaragoza).

What do we need by 2023?

\$455,000 to move into a larger building

\$30,000 for facility upgrades and outfit

\$325,000 renovations and upgrades

\$100,000 classroom outfit for increased enrollment





What are our long term needs?

\$6 million for land, building and fees for a preschool-grade 12 central campus (up to 600 students)

Seed money to start satellite campuses in the greater Madrid area (\$300,000) per school.

Seed money to reproduce the educational model in other cities of Spain
