# When God becomes a Reality

- <sup>8</sup> Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?"
- And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"
- <sup>9</sup> He said, "Go and tell this people:
- "Be ever hearing, but never understanding; be ever seeing, but never perceiving."
- <sup>10</sup> Make the heart of this people calloused; make their ears dull and close their eyes.
- Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts, and turn and be healed."
- <sup>11</sup> Then I said, "For how long, Lord?"

#### And he answered:

- "Until the cities lie ruined and without inhabitant, until the houses are left deserted
- and the fields ruined and ravaged,


  12 until the LORD has sent everyone far away




1. A God-Quake

weight/weightiness




## God as a concept versus God as a reality


# Radical beauty- Holy, Holy, Holy (3 times)



# (kadosh): superlativeness, infinitely unique, brilliance and beauty




# Humility - "Woe to me"




Woe is a curse and Isaiah is a prophet!

Isaiah is the man with a golden tongue. He lives in an oral culture. He realizes **he** is the problem.






# Angel fly's with a live coal and touches Isaiah's lips




