### **Complaint #1 – It’s your fault, God! (vs. 1-4)**

**Exodus 34:6-7**

Why was Jonah angry? 1) Racist; 2) Ninevites responded/Israelites didn’t; 3) they deserved judgement; 4) limited view of God; 5) make him look bad (message was wrong); 6) what would others think (he facilitated Ninevites revival).

### **Complaint #2 – It’s still your fault, God! (vs. 5-9)**

God’s discipline: **Hebrews 12:9-11**

**God’s response: I do care! (vs. 10-11)**

**Psalm 103:8-14**

Conclusion: Three takeaways from our text

1. **Be very careful when you get angry**            **James 1:19-22; Ephesians 4:26-27**
2. **Run towards God when you are disappointed with Him**            **Isaiah 55:6-11**
3. **Deepen your understanding of God**
