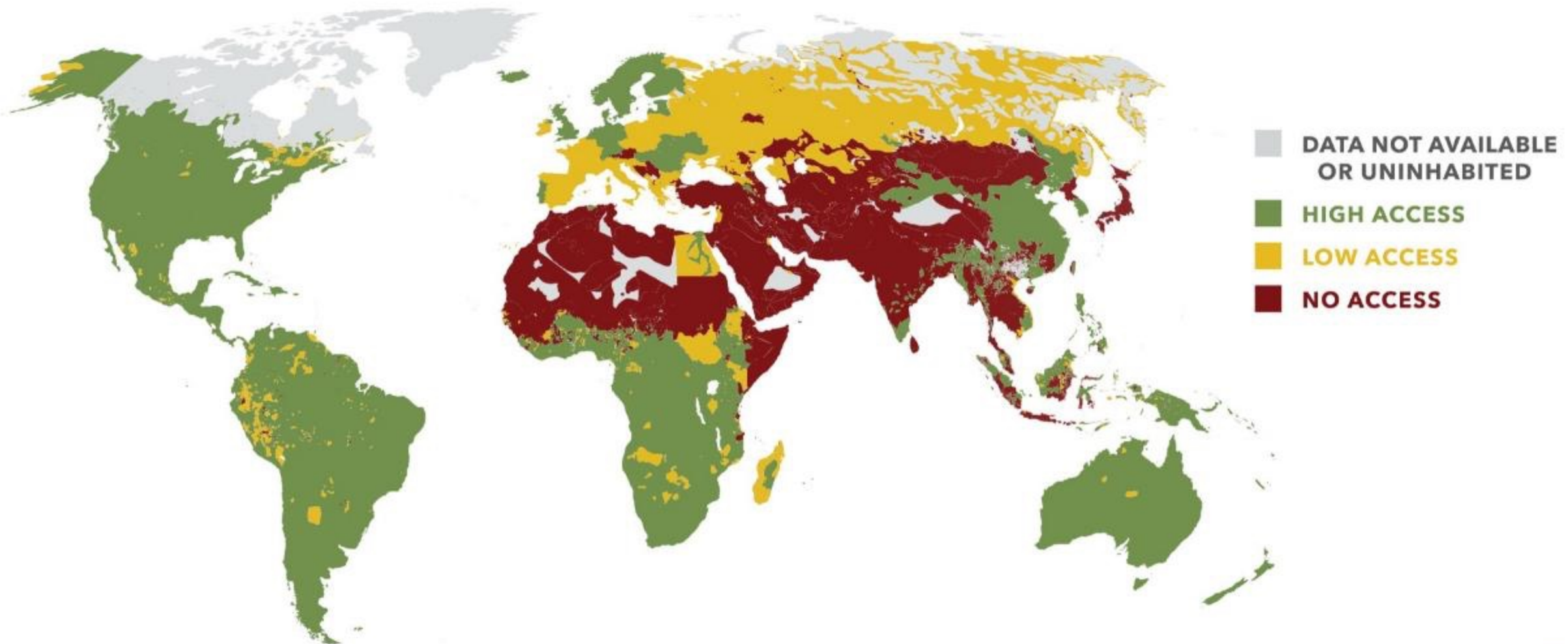

# PROGRESS OF THE GOSPEL

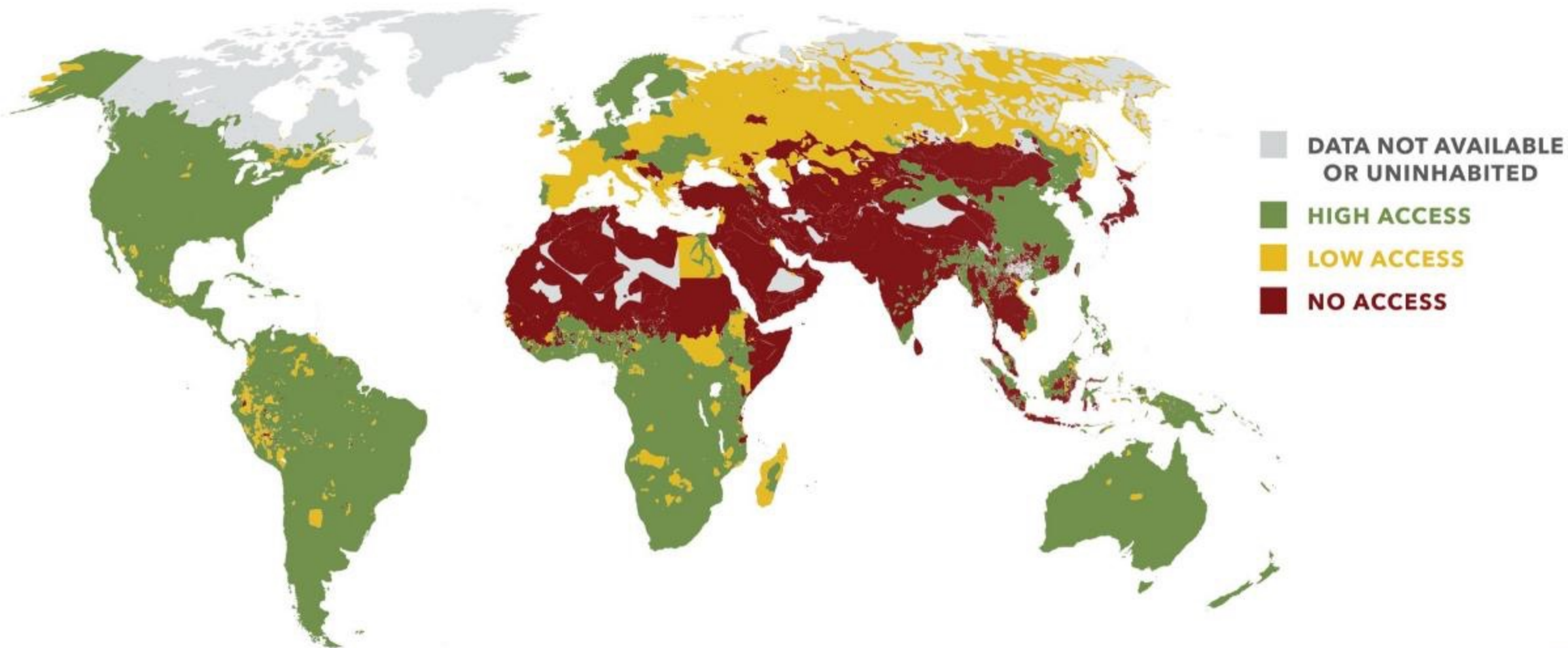

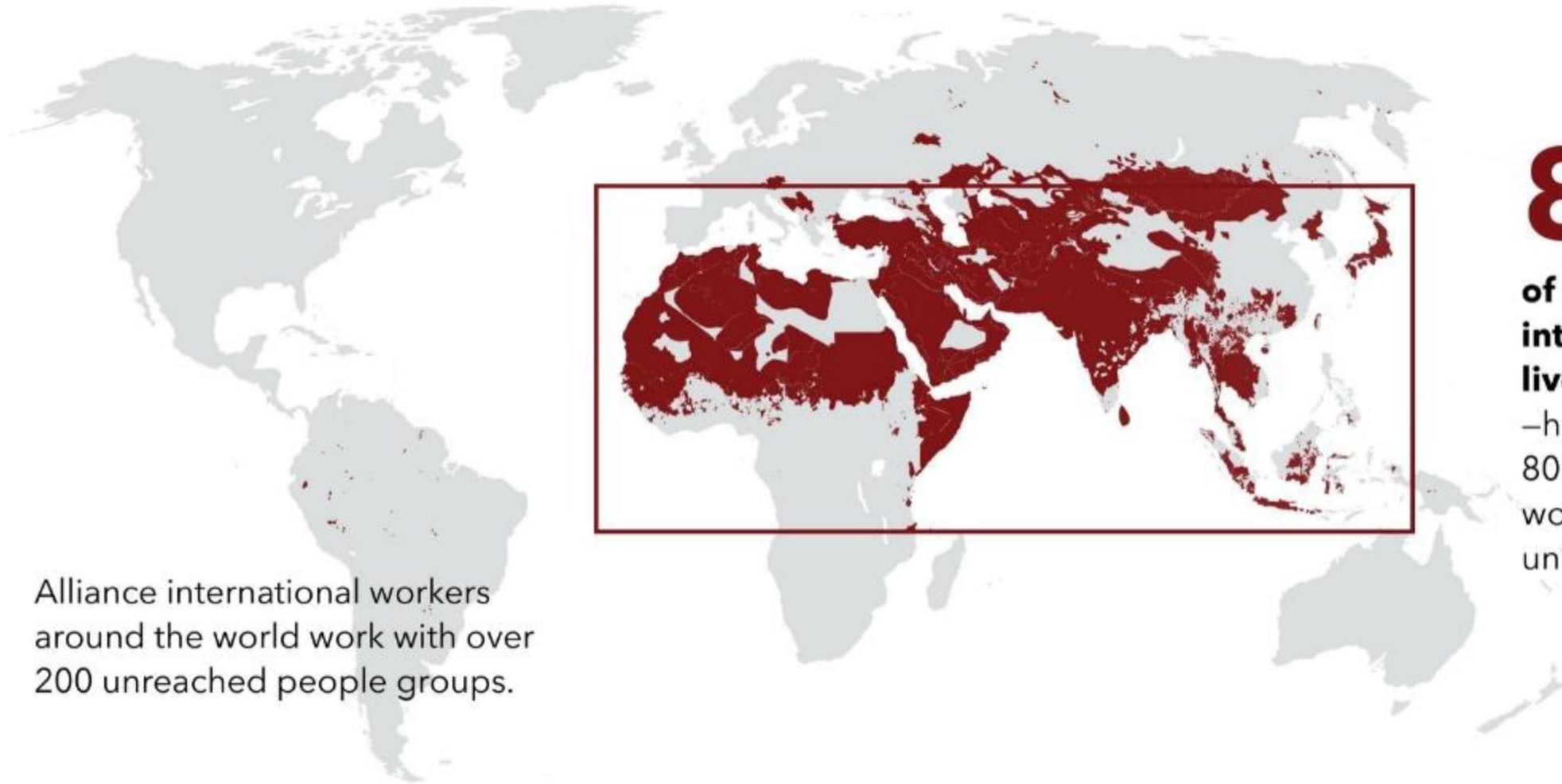

Two couples, the Hammonds and Ellisons, were the first long-term missionaries to Cambodia and began Gospel ministry there in 1923.



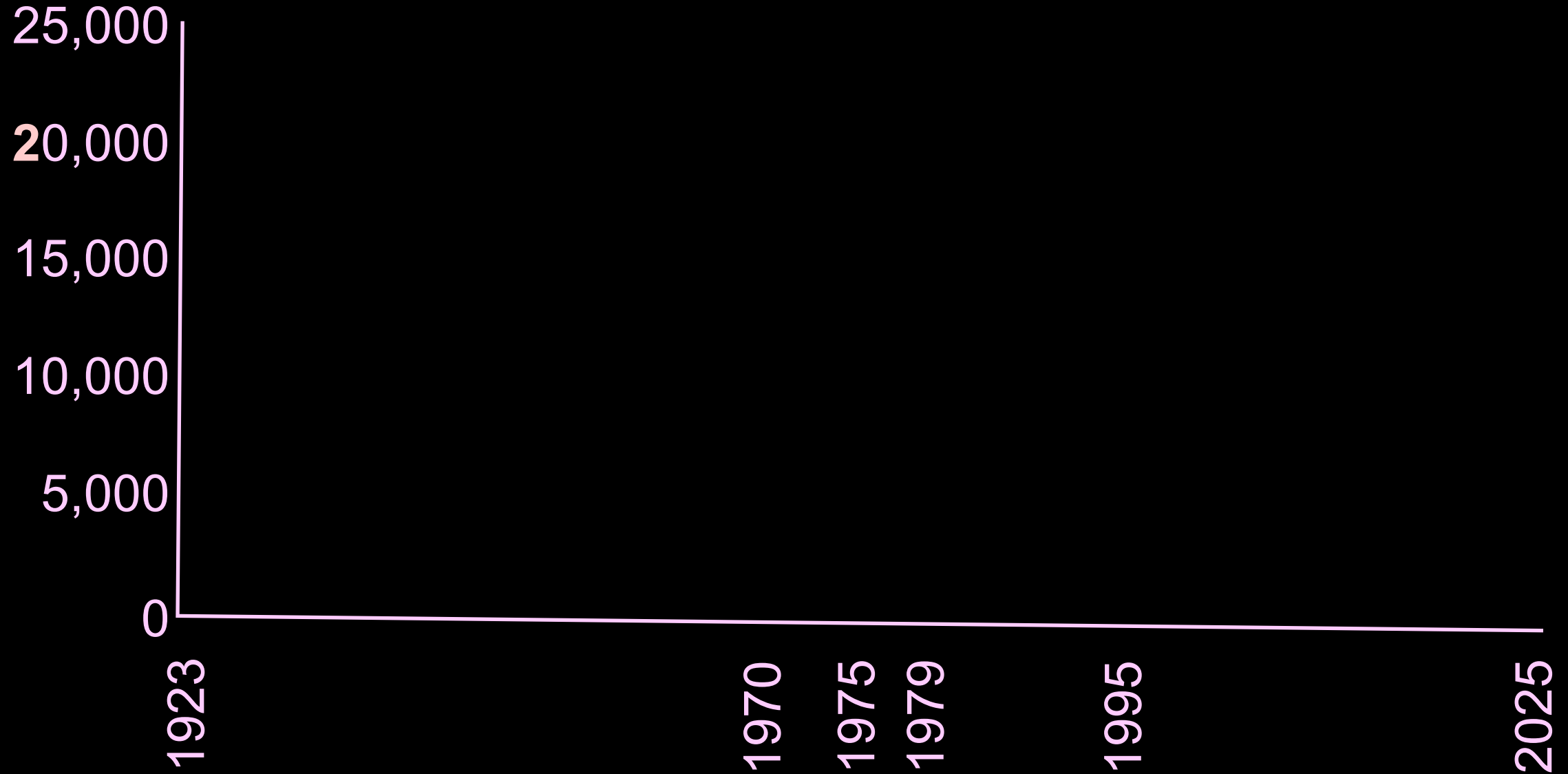

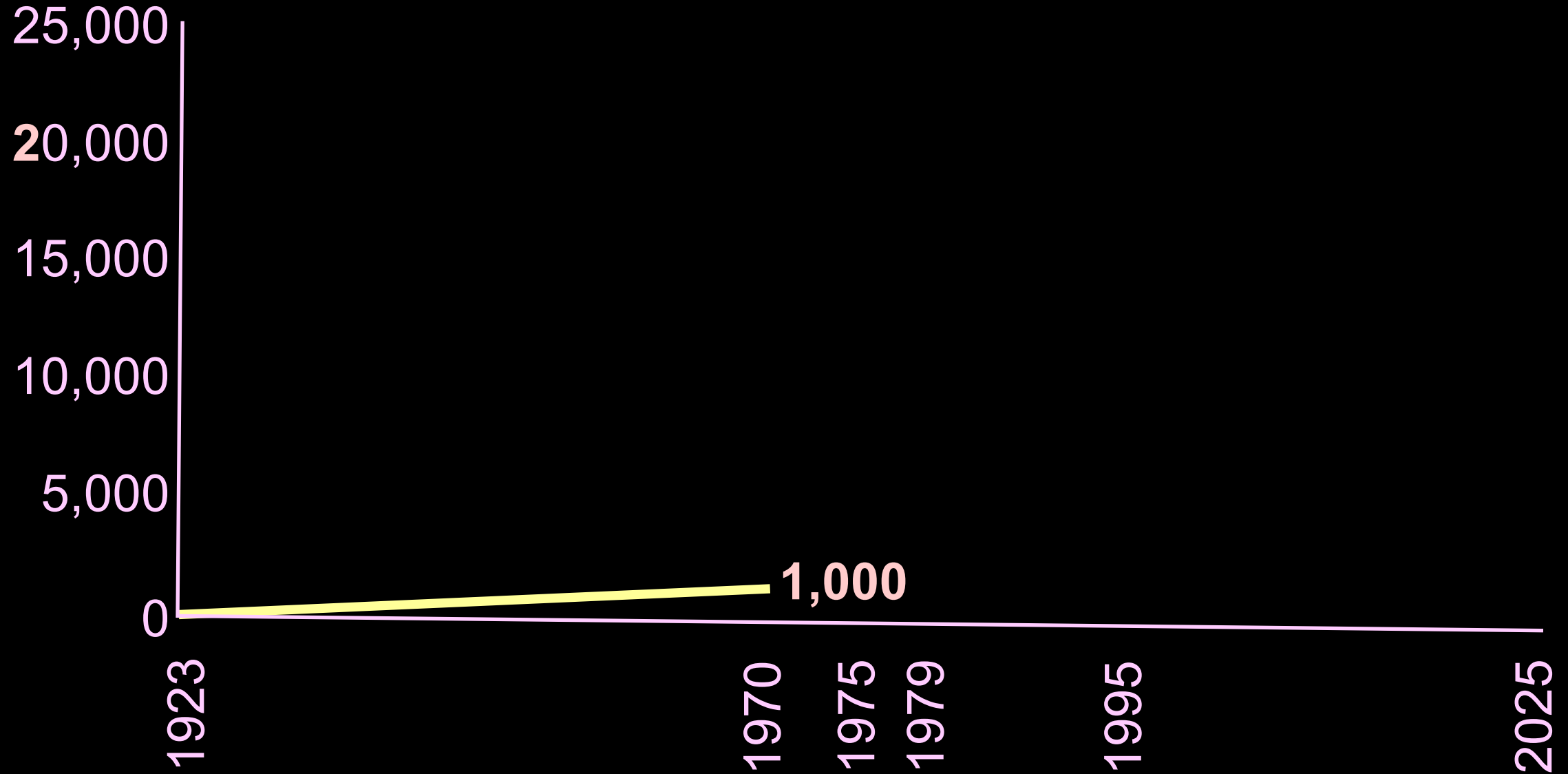

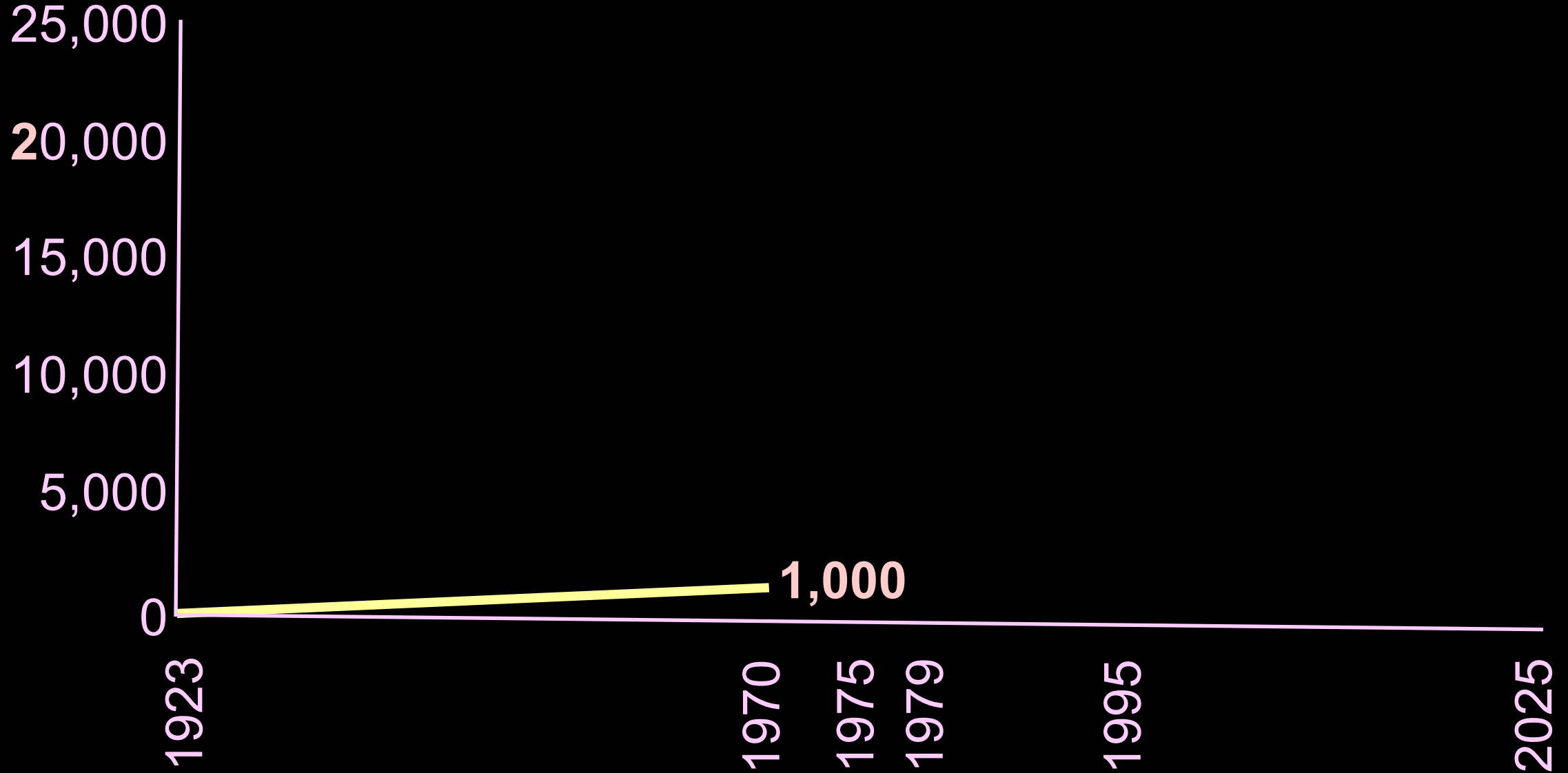

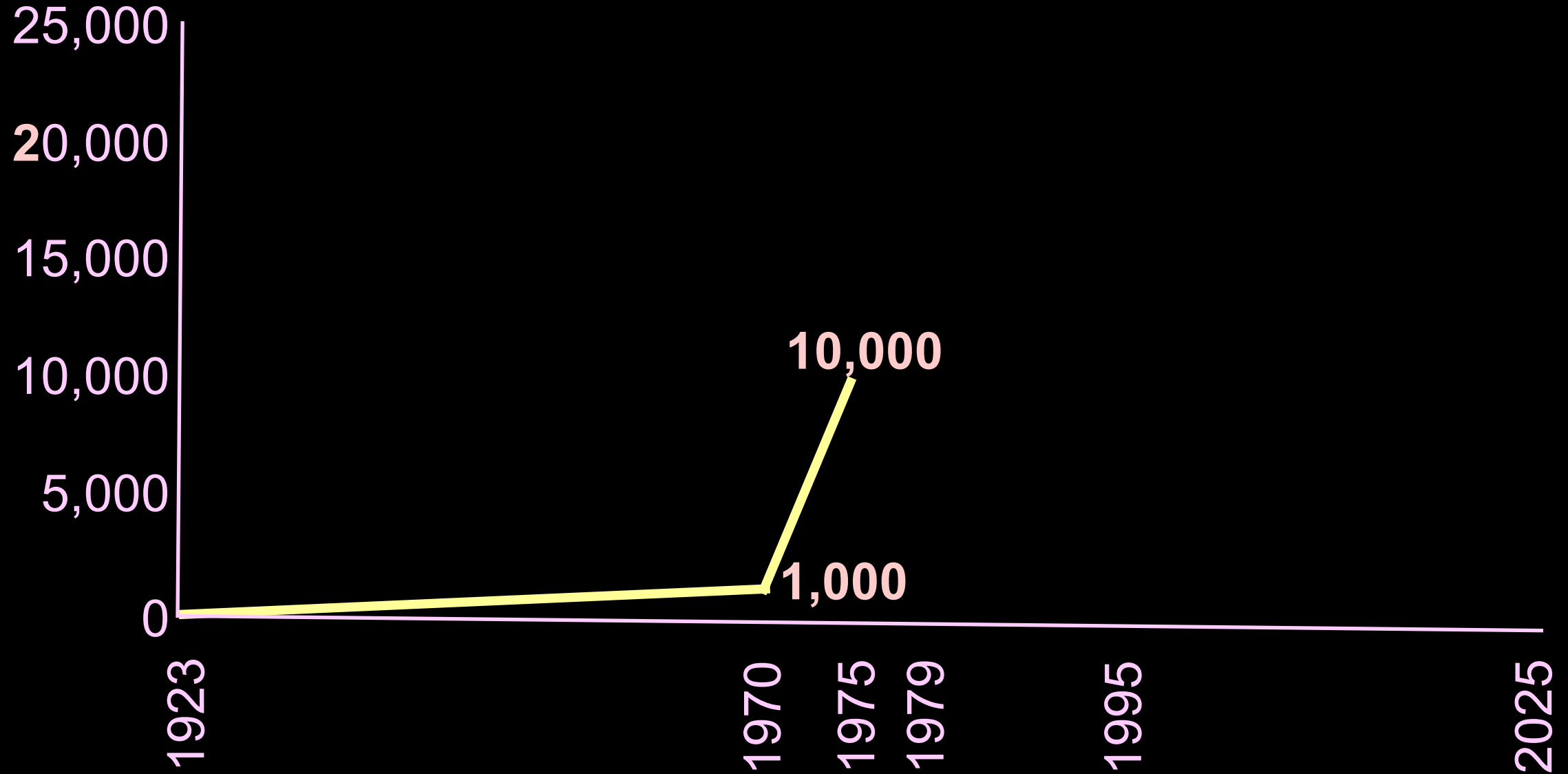

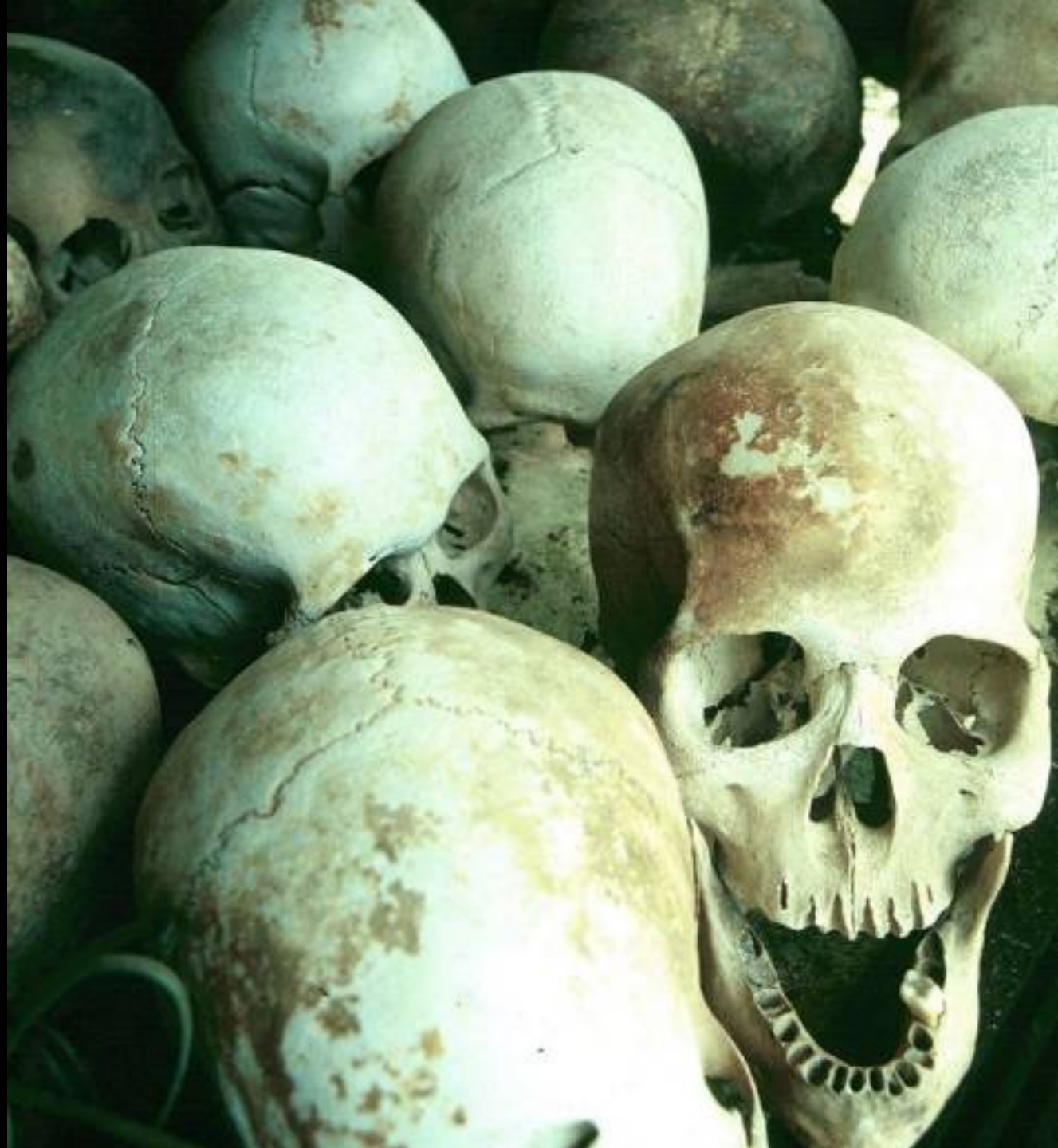

# The Khmer Rouge Killing Fields

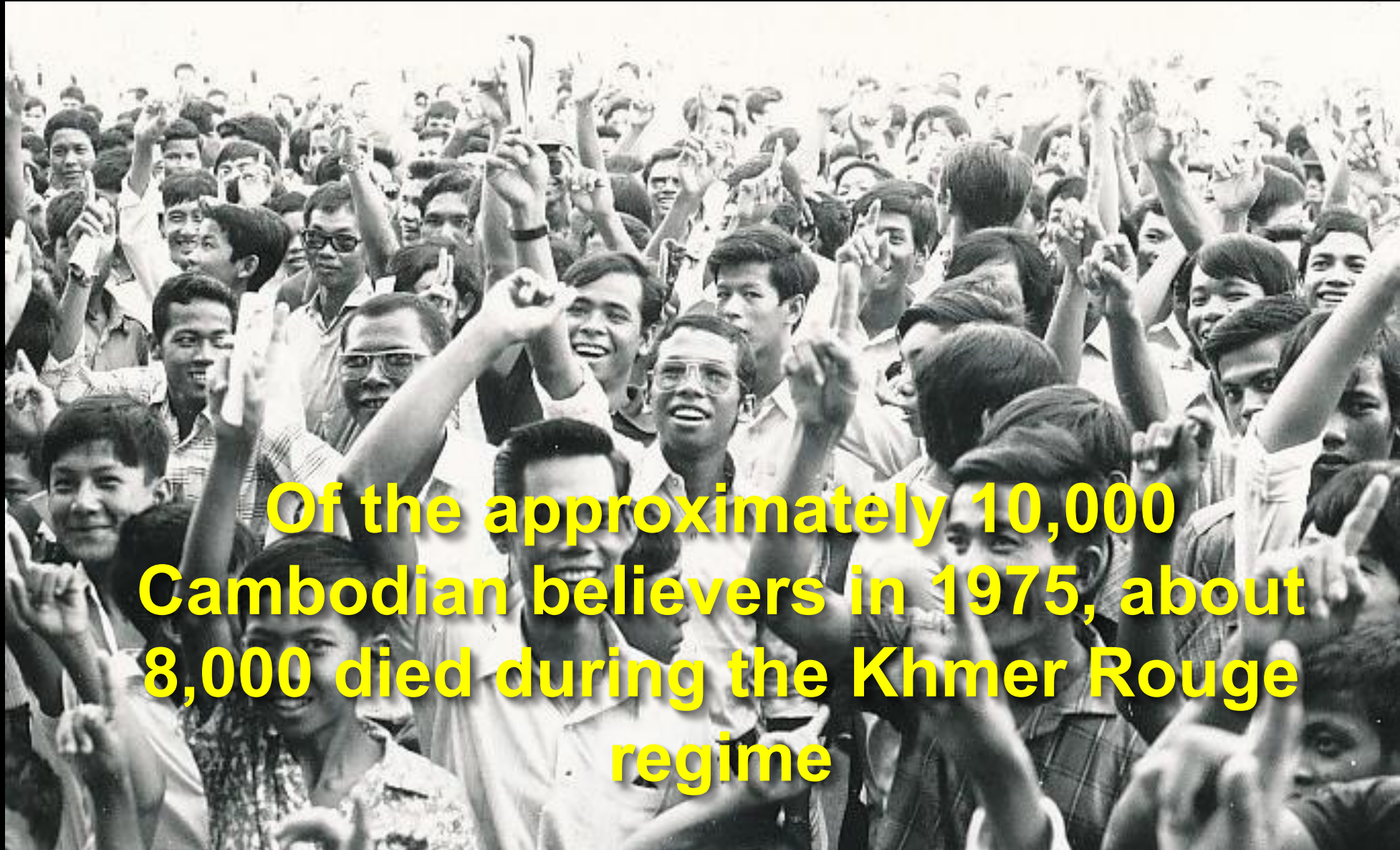

### 3. The Cham people in Cambodia





There are about 250,000 Cham in Cambodia. Of these, there are about 30 known believers. This works out to one believer for every 7,000 Cham.



- Jeff and Heather Williams began to live in a simple hut in a Cham village in 2002.
- They learned the Cham language, helped eradicate Tuberculosis from the village using the DOTS program, and shared the Gospel.
- Through their ministry, several Cham came to Christ.

*“There was no movement, Mah Nah went stiff,  
cold, no breathing...”*

*Selpriah (her daughter) started calling everyone to say that she had died. The villagers all came to start preparations for the funeral. The religious leaders in the village opened up the mosque in the night and made the announcement that she had died. “ Old Men, Old Women, Sister Mah Nah has died...”*

2016

*As is custom, people came to say their last apologies to her... By their religious custom, the body must be buried quickly, so things started being done...*

*But then Mah Nah started breathing again! And moving...*

*Everyone got all excited, and kept on saying their apologies but now she was listening!...*

*But then she started speaking words of forgiveness to everyone... One by one the religious leaders, the neighbors, her family... The more she spoke forgiveness, the more easily she was able to talk.*

*The village elders then went back to the mosque to make another announcement. "Sister Mah Nah is not dead! She is fine!"*

2016

*The “temperature” of the village is comfortable again, cool and breezy! I walk around, and discuss this amazing thing that happened with ease. The village leaders have given us permission to “be friends” again. They struggle to understand this power that is so strong it can change hearts.*

*Not often does an announcement have to be made from the Mosque that someone is alive again. Perhaps this is our chance!*
