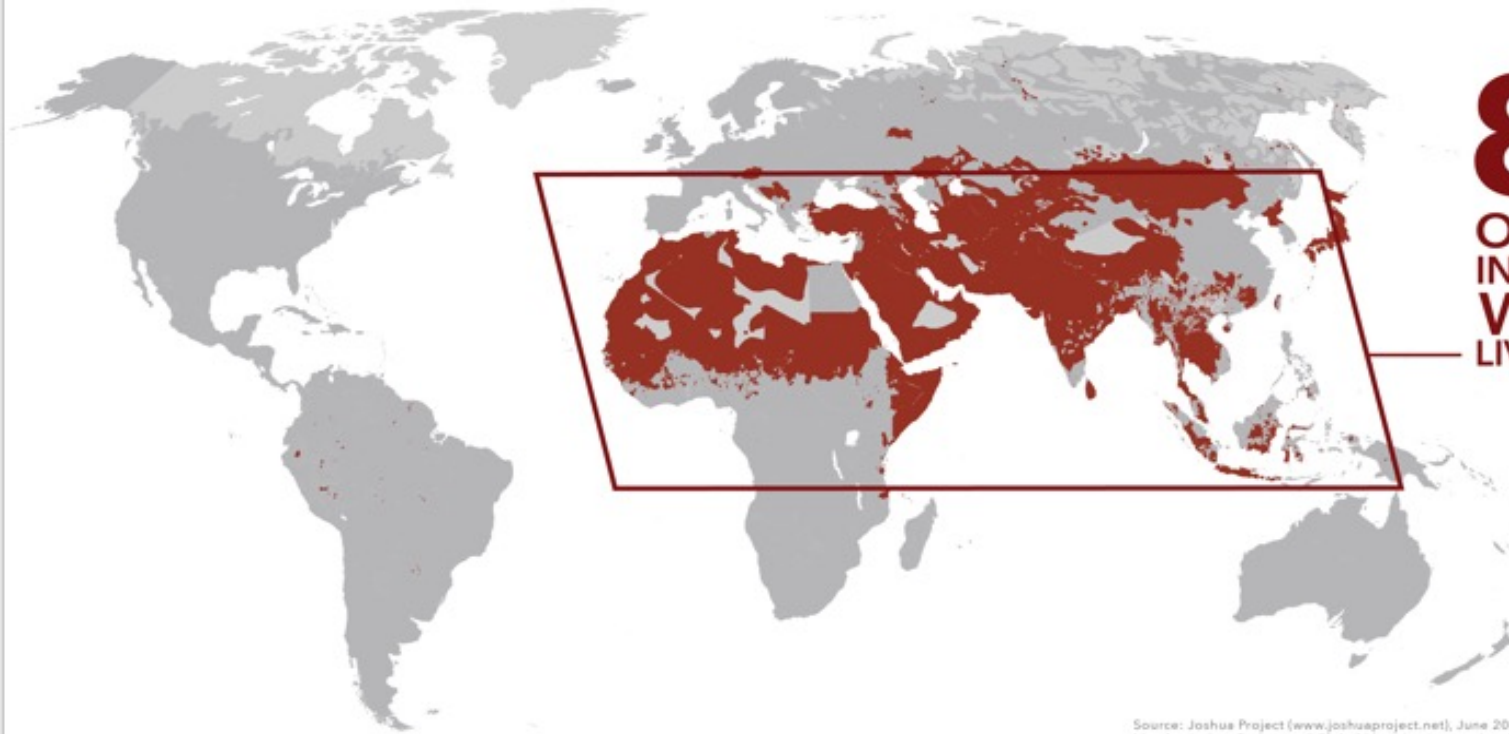

¹⁷ So I have reason to be enthusiastic about all Christ Jesus has done through me in my service to God. ¹⁸ Yet I dare not boast about anything except **what Christ has done** through me, bringing the Gentiles to God by my message and by the way I worked among them. ¹⁹ They were convinced by the power of miraculous signs and wonders and **by the power of God's Spirit.**^[a] In this way, I have fully presented the Good News of Christ from Jerusalem all the way to Illyricum.^[b]
